

## Notes on Accredited Membership

---

There are two routes to COSRT accreditation:

1. **Category One:** for those who have successfully completed a COSRT approved course. Some applicants may be eligible for UKCP registration (see notes below). Within Category One, there are two divisions:
  - a. Applicants who have successfully completed a two-year or three-year COSRT approved course. This can lead to COSRT accreditation but not normally to UKCP registration. Click here for [criteria](#) and [application form](#).
  - b. Applicants who have successfully completed a four-year COSRT approved course at Masters level. This can lead to COSRT accreditation and UKCP registration. Click here for [criteria](#) and [application form](#).
  
2. **Category Two:** for those who have not undertaken a COSRT approved course. Applicants who have completed a two-year course are not normally eligible for UKCP registration. Applicants who have completed a four-year course at Masters level may be eligible for UKCP registration. Click here for [criteria](#) and [application form](#).

**Please note that documents are subject to review and renewal.**

- Your request for COSRT Accreditation should be made in writing to the Chair of the Assessors Panel.
- You can apply under either Category One or Category Two. There is a separate application form for each type of accreditation. Please complete the correct form.
- The completed documentation (plus requested copies) and the processing fee of £100 sterling made payable to COSRT should be returned to the Chair of the Assessors Panel.
- The Assessors Panel will consider the application and make a recommendation to the Professional Standards Board.
- If your application for Accreditation is rejected and you wish to Appeal, write to the Chair of the Assessors Panel requesting details of the Appeals Procedure.
