

Criteria for Annual Renewal of Accreditation

In order to maintain your status as an accredited member of COSRT you are required to comply with the following criteria. [Please see note below.]

1. Agree to abide by our [Codes of Ethics and Principles of Good Practice for Members](#).
2. Have completed a minimum of 16 hours of continuous professional development in the last year ([see Policy on Continuous Professional Development](#)). A minimum of eight hours of CPD must be relevant to sexual and relationship therapy.
3. Be a practitioner of sexual and relationship therapy, with at least 100 hours of face to face work in the last year.
4. Have had no unauthorised breaks in practice longer than three months.
5. Have adequate supervision for the caseload you carry (not less than one hour per month) (see [Guidelines for Supervision of Sexual and Relationship Therapy](#)). To confirm this, your supervisor's signature is required.
6. Be adequately insured.
7. Sign a declaration.

NOTE

COSRT reserves the right to change any of the criteria required for annual renewal of accreditation and to audit the applications by requiring documentary evidence to be produced on request.
